On 6/22/20 at approximately 1923 hours PO Crowdes and I were dispatched to 5509 NE Oaks Ridge Ln in regard to a reported past physical domestic assault.

Upon arrival to the residence, a distraught w/f later identified as Logan Day (Sus), was sitting on the front steps. She stated the following:

Shortly before calling us, her boyfriend Richard threw her on the ground because she went to wake him up. After she woke him up, he became angry, picked her up and threw her down onto the ground. She then went outside to wait for police.

She advised she is staying at the residence to take care of him as he has severe back problems. She began to apologize saying she was sorry for wasting our time and that he (Richard) is not a bad guy. She kept saying "sorry" and that "he doesn't like me." She also stated that she suffers from Bi-polar disorder and is on several medications for the condition. While on scene I observed no obvious injury to Logan.

Contact was then made with Richard Kyanka (vic) in the basement of the house. He was in bed when he spoke to me. He stated the following:

He had decided to go to sleep early tonight as he has surgery in the morning. He believed that him going to sleep early upset Logan and that he felt that she was having a "manic episode," as she is bi-polar. According to him, she came downstairs to where he was at and kicked him in his lower back where he will have the operation. At some point, she asked him how it would feel if she had a knife in his back.

He then showed me a text message exchange between the two illustrating the fact that Logan was upset he was going to bed early and something to the effect of her never getting to spend any time with him. In the same conversation she mentioned wanting to "end her life." Richard mentioned to me that he did not believe she was suicidal and that she was probably saying those things to "get a rise out of him." I asked him if he threw her down onto the floor and he said that after she kicked him, he got out of bed and then slipped onto the floor, taking her down with him. I observed him to be virtually bed-ridden and had difficulty moving on the bed to demonstrate what had occurred between him and Logan. He denied medical attention on scene.

I then re-contacted Logan and asked her if she made any statements in reference to hurting herself. She acted surprised and stated "no..if I wanted to do that I would check myself in somewhere." I asked her if she wanted to harm herself/others multiple times throughout our contact and each time she stated "no." I asked her about the knife remark and she stated that she did not say anything about a knife. She simply went downstairs to talk to Richard. I asked her if it were possible that she and Richard fell onto the floor, instead of him picking her up and throwing her down. She said "it was possible.. but everything happened so fast...maybe I am the bad guy." She had been drinking today because she was lonely and wanted to spend time with Richard.

Due to conflicting statements and lack of witnesses, no arrest was made.

Logan was given a courtesy escort to Best Western (4825 NE Lakewood Way) to difuse for the night.
